Sales Tax:

*Most* food items typically do not require you to collect sales tax but other items such as crafts (soaps, woodworking projects, etc) and potted plants do require it. Vendors are responsible for getting their own tax permit. For more information, check out the link provided below.

- All items sold must be grown and/or made by the vendor – no purchasing for resale
- Vendor Fee: \$20 for the season – this will be put towards advertising and other market costs
- Market Hours: Every Monday from 4-6pm with set up beginning at 3:30. Please be set up and ready to sell no later than 4pm
